Child Protection Teams

The Children and Families Fieldwork Teams are the first point of contact for people with concerns about a child - anything from a parent concerned about their child's behaviour and wanting some advice, to serious incidents where the police have intervened and removed a child from a situation.

Children and Families Fieldwork Teams work with children and their families on cases involving child protection or child placement, such as fostering and supported lodgings.

The Chlamydia Screening Lead

Chlamydia is the most commonly diagnosed bacterial sexually transmitted infection. The highest prevalence is amongst young people aged between 15 and 24 years of age. One in ten people who take the test in this age group will be found to be positive. The Chlamydia Screening Programme was launched in 2005 to increase access to screening for young people.
