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If you are 18 or over, empathetic and a good listener, we have the following volunteering opportunities for you:

Community Mentors spend around an hour a week with a young person for up to a year and can provide support with self-esteem, social skills or working towards goals.

Primary mentors spend around an hour each week in primary schools during the school day supporting children to build resilience by having fun and trying new things.

Referral order panel members represent the community ensuring young people who offend take responsibility for their actions and help change their behaviour.

Appropriate adults look after the interests of young people who are being interviewed by police at the police station when a parent or guardian is not available.

Parent mentors support parents whose child or young person is being exploited or at risk of exploitation

Transitional mentors support vulnerable young people aged 16 – 25 as they move into adulthood
