

## Dear Head Teacher,

We are writing to you because it has been brought to the attention of the Wiltshire Youth Council from many of our peers at our respective schools that young people in the county would like to play a more active role in providing aid to Ukrainian refugees.

We propose that Friday 1<sup>st</sup> April be a day in which students can attend school in non-school uniform wearing blue and yellow for a minimum donation of £1, the money will be donated to The Ukraine Disaster Emergency Committee Crisis Appeal who are providing urgent humanitarian aid including food, water, shelter, healthcare and protection.

This campaign will be marked as Youth4Ukraine. Any similar initiatives or campaigns you can organise as a school community to increase awareness and engagement on this approach will be greatly appreciated.
