Criminal Justice Interventions

We work closely with Police and Probation services to deliver the Drug Intervention Project (DIP) services via custody suites and magistrates courts. We can also provide treatment for Drug Rehabilitation Requirement (DRR) treatment court orders, and Alcohol Treatment Requirement (ATR) court orders. We actively support the Integrated Offender Management service 'SWITCH' across Wiltshire.

1-2-1 and Group Support

We will offer a wide range of support, including, 1-2-1 interventions, key-working, group support and counselling, delivered in line with your recovery. We will provide you with a constant Care Coordinator who will support and guide you through all the services available and a wide range of groups.

Aftercare and Community re-integration

We will support you to gain access to meaningful activities such as education, training, and employment.

Anybody affected by substance misuse, including families and significant others can contact the service to access support.





Community detoxification

Our Community Detox Nurses will deliver detoxifications for drug and/or alcohol giving you the option to avoid In-Patient detox.

In-patient detoxification

We will support you in to In-Patient detoxification or residential rehabilitation from the point of your referral to your discharge should this be your choice. We will provide you with the appropriate care and support during this time to suit your individual needs.

Specialist prescribing

Through each of our main centres we offer service users quick access to a prescription such as Methadone, following an assessment with our doctors, nurses and Recovery Workers. We will work closely with GPs through our Shared Care Scheme and look to transfer your prescription into the community by a GP when appropriate
