

FREE Introductory online training: Bereavement Support for Children & Young People (duration 90mins max)

Learning Outcomes: Understand age related grieving behaviours and simple, practical methods of supporting children and young people. Know where and how you can signpost for specialist support.

Who is this course for? This training will provide a good, basic level of understanding for all professionals who come into contact with children & young people.

It is most suited to those who are responsible for identifying bereaved individuals and offering initial support and signposting. For example school staff and social care, health, youth, faith and community workers.

We strongly suggest that a higher level of training is more appropriate for professionals who hold responsibility for undertaking in depth work aimed at supporting a child's emotional development and wellbeing following a bereavement. This is in order to fully explore the complexities of bereavement that are not covered in this introductory training. Such professionals may include school pastoral staff, early help and mental health staff.
